Spaces will be determined by the LMA Committee and based on merchandise category and load-in ease of operations. In most cases, your vehicle will be in the same parking lot as your booth. The street will not be closed to traffic. There will be concerted effort to group dealers/organizations/neighbors with similar exhibitors to increase traffic and interest to those groups. A valid vendor's license is required, and all sales tax liabilities will be met by the vendor. Directions and load-in instructions will follow your signed and pre-paid contract, or call for details. All items must be priced for sale. We hope everyone has a wonderful and profitable time.
